Those who have been involved in our community for a long time, and those who just want to ensure that there will always be a place in this province for our young people to encounter Christ in creation.

One of the greatest ways you can support OLVC is through general donations. Donation such as these go towards supporting our summer program and off-season activities. In particular, we are always seeking *monthly* donors of any amount- even \$20 a month is of tremendous help to us. That being said, we have a number of specific needs that we need help meeting. These range from immediately imperative maintenance projects to capital projects that will help Camp grow for years to come. Below, you'll find an itemized list of all of these projects, along with their expected costs (being either quoted or estimated.)

Immediate Maintenance Needs

The four years of closure that OLVC endured between 2019 and 2023 made the state of much of our aging infrastructure especially apparent. These projects will need completion as soon as possible, and at the top of our fundraising priorities for this year.

- A new hot water tank for our Mess Hall - **\$10,000**
- An overhaul of the boiler system in Jubilee Hall, our girls dormitory - **\$10,000**
- A new hot water tank in Jubilee Hall - **~\$10,000**
- Reconfiguring one of our overflow dormitories to house our nursing station - **\$20,000**
- New stoves in our kitchen to replace those that have fallen into disrepair - **~\$20,000**
- Lumber for rebuilding the platform we use for outdoor masses - **~\$5,000**
- Grass seed and fertilizer for ground repairs, and sand for the gaga ball pit - **~\$3,000**
- A replacement for Cook's Inn, our cook's residence, which has fallen into disrepair- **\$75,000**

Maintenance Wish List

These are items and projects that we would very much like to fund over the coming years, but which are not immediate needs.

- Heating for our maintenance shop - **\$1,000**

- A new-to-us pickup truck - ~\$8,000
- LED light conversion on all of our buildings - ~\$2,000
- A new-to-us tractor - ~\$10,000
- A 40 foot trailer for canoe storage - \$10,000

Program-related purchases

These items help us to continue to provide the quality of programming to our summer campers that we have come to pride ourselves on.

- Three new canoes - \$3500
- One new archery target- \$500
- New archery equipment (bows, etc.) - \$4000
- A climbing wall to provide a new and exciting activity for campers - \$50,000
